





Support and fundraising efforts for British F4 racer Billy Monger are set to continue at Thruxton this weekend (6/7 May) as the Dunlop MSA British Touring Car Championship and TOCA package descend on the Hampshire circuit for the third event of the year.

Following on from being involved in a serious incident at Donington Park, the motorsport community has rallied behind the teenager, raising nearly £800,000 in a matter of weeks – with that number set to increase further at the fastest circuit in the UK.

Messages of support will adorn a majority of the cars competing on the grid this weekend.

For BTCC machines, #BillyWhizz will run on each car's front number plate position, replacing title sponsors Dunlop. Cars from the Simpson Race Products Ginetta Junior Championship and Protyre Motorsport Ginetta GT5 Challenge will also carry the same strapline on their windscreen decals.

Competitors in the British F4 Championship and Renault UK Clio Cup will also have artwork displayed on their cars.

WALK THE TRACK FOR BILLY

On Saturday evening, following the final track action of the day, a track walk will take place to raise money for Billy. Providing a rare opportunity to get a closer look at one of the most infamous tracks in the UK, fans will be able to walk side-by-side with drivers and teams for a great cause.
