Paddock Access – see BARC Finals; Paddock Plan

Clio Cup Series teams will be situated in Paddock A2 (small paddock by the garages) with access from 3pm on Thursday 27th April. You MUST set up on the side of the paddock closest to the pit lane and keep tight please. A clear roadway and pathway must be left through the paddock at all times. Please note we will be sharing this paddock with 2CV's so pleased be mindful of space available.

Croft Circuit; changes to paddock

The Assembley Area and Parc Ferme areas have been re-located. The Clerk of the Course will confirm details and procedures during the driver briefing however please take note of item #11 within the BARC finals relating to Circuit Access and Egress.

General Testing

There is a general test day at Croft circuit on Friday 28^{th} April. Full Day - 4 x 30 mins sessions - £160.00 plus £32.00 VAT = £192.00 Half Day (PM ONLY) - 2 x 30 mins sessions - £80.00 plus £16.00 VAT = £96.00. The timetable will be confirmed directly to all drivers taking part by the circuit in due course. For bookings please call Croft direct on 01325 721815.

Competitor Tickets

Tickets will be posted direct from BARC and each competitor will receive five passes, no vehicle passes will be issued for this event. Please ensure you enter as soon as possible to ensure safe receipt of tickets.

Clerk of the Course

Noise Checking

All cars will be noise tested in the assembly area on Saturday therefore please ensure you are ready in plenty of time before the start of your qualifying session.

Engines must not run before 09:15 or after 18:30 on any day.

Driver Briefing

Driver's briefing will be held on Saturday at 10:00hrs directly after sign on. Signing on for the briefing is mandatory and all drivers must attend. Failure to attend will result in a fine. New Driver Briefings will be incorporated into the main Driver Briefing.

Mandy will confirm the location for the drivers briefing.

Podium Presentation

Trophy presentations will take place in the pit lane, in front of Race Control. Drivers required for the podium from both Race & Road classes should make their way from Parc Ferme as quickly as possible please.

Technical Information

• Technical Scrutineer: Keith Auld

• **Fuel: As per Championship Regulation 5.16.3.1**. Pump Fuel to MSA Regulations must be used (see definition; Nomenclature and Definitions; MSA Reg J5.13.4). This includes both Unleaded and Super Unleaded from any source. Teams must be able to provide receipts for fuel purchased for this event if required to do so by the Technical Scrutineer.

• Protyre: Protyre will be situated at the top of paddock A and open from 08:00hrs on Friday. Teams must leave a set of wheels with Protyre by 15:00hrs on Friday for race tyres to be fitted

• Scales: Championship scales will be available from 08:00hrs on Saturday morning in the Scrutineering Bay

Important Note – Driver Licences

Drivers must remember to collect their race licences and upgrade cards at the end of the meeting. Due to the number of items currently being lost in the post, drivers who leave their upgrade card for CoC signature and do not collect them at the end of the meeting, leave them at their own risk. For the avoidance of doubt, BARC will return uncollected cards by 1st class post , on the day following the event but will accept no responsibility whatsoever if the card does not reach the intended recipient.
