Thankfully Butcher emerged almost immediately unscathed from the incident, however it did lead to the red flags being brought out as the car had to be removed from the track. Positions changed several times in the nail biting rescheduled 12-lap sprint before we saw Ollie Jackson claim his first ever Kwik Fit BTCC victory.

It's very tight at the top of the standings, with 17 points separating the top three, so everyone will be looking to boost their tally going into the last two weekends.

Teams and drivers are, without doubt, missing the fans being there to cheer them on, but safety continues to be paramount in the BTCC and we take the Covid specific measures very seriously, especially as government adapts its instructions to react to the changing situation. At Kwik Fit, our centres remained open throughout the lockdown period in order to support key workers and those making other essential journeys, so we have first-hand experience of how important it is to follow safety protocols. 





THE RACE IS ON AT

The Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship has reached the business end of the season and as the series arrives at Croft for Rounds 19, 20 & 21, it's game on for the biggest prize in UK motorsport. Chris Ashby sets the scene.

Three events, nine races and a maximum of 201 points up for grabs - that's all that remains of the 2020 Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship season and this weekend's three contests in North Yorkshire could prove pivotal in deciding who will walk away with the coveted crown.

Since blasting back into life in August, Britain's Sutton's team-mate, Aiden Moffat, has started to premier race series has been relentless not only with its condensed schedule but also in terms of the entertainment it has provided, with thrills 'n' spills coming around almost every corner.

As has been the case all season, the BTCC's annual visit to Croft will unfortunately be run without its customary bumper trackside crowd due to it taking place behind closed doors because of the ongoing coronavirus restrictions.

Coming off the back of a sensational Silverstone meeting, Laser Tools Racing's Ashley Sutton enters the seventh event of the season holding a slender four-point advantage at the summit of the standings.

At the wheel of the Infiniti Q50, the 2017 champion has hit new heights this year. Jaw-dropping drives along with four wins have been the cornerstone of his title challenge and he arrives at a venue which has proven to be a happy hunting ground in the past in the box seat.

click with the rear-wheel-drive Q50 in recent events and the Scotsman will be one to keep an eye on as he chases down his first podium of the year.

Leading the chase for Sutton is four-time reigning champion Colin Turkington. Gunning for a recordbreaking fifth crown, the Team BMW driver added a third win to his tally last time out and the chase is very much on with Sutton now. Touted as the 'King of Croft', you can bet the Northern Irishman will be firmly in the mix.

On the other side of the West Surrey Racing garage is Tom Oliphant, who is currently in midst of his best-ever season in the BTCC. Victory at Brands Hatch coupled with three additional podiums have made Oliphant a regular front-runner in the series and he's hungry for more success.



Halfords Yuasa Racing's Dan Cammish can't be discounted from the title picture either after he was victorious at Silverstone. After dropping away slightly early on, big points scores at Thruxton and Silverstone have vaulted the Yorkshireman firmly back into contention ahead of his home race.

With three-time champion Matt Neal in his corner as well, teamwork will be key for the Honda outfit as they aim to close the gap on the top two.

Tom Ingram was the driver to beat at Thruxton, powering his way to a brace of wins, but two nonscores last time out has left him with plenty of work to do sitting fourth in the standings.

The Toyota Gazoo Racing with Ginsters ace is renowned for his never-give-up attitude and that means he will be one to watch in his rapid Corolla.

Rounding out the top five in the points is Motorbase Performance's Rory Butcher, who arrives at Croft off the back of a scary high-speed accident at Silverstone. Well rested and with his Ford Focus having been rebuilt, the Scotsman will be looking to repay his teams hard work with a big points haul as

Motorbase can now boast to running two race winners after Ollie Jackson scored a popular breakthrough win at Silverstone. After more than 200 races, Jackson commanded the reverse grid encounter to triumph, and that will surely only push him forward here. Andy Neate drives the teams third car.

BTC Racing claimed their first-ever victory in the BTCC here at Croft back in 2018 and the Civic Type R squad will be keen to repeat the feat this year. Josh Cook is already a race-winner in 2020 whilst Tom Chilton has come close, netting two podiums Down the years Croft has been well-suited to the to-date so far.

Michael Crees pilots the teams third Honda and the Boardley, both of whom run the hatchback this year fan favourite has been a front-runner in the Jack Sears Trophy.

Excelr8 Motorsport have enjoyed a groundbreaking year with their brand-new Hyundai i30N's and local man Senna Proctor will be keen to give it another big result on home turf. Team-mate Chris Smiley, a keen to bag some big points as well.

MB Motorsport with Blue Square's Jake Hill and Sam Osborne, as well as the Carlube Triple R Racing with and Morgan in particular have been regular fixtures towards the front of the field, the latter winning at Oulton Park.

Elsewhere, GKR TradePriceCars.com Audi's have been in the thick of the action this year with Bobby

BMW 1-Series and that could suit Team Parker Racing's Stephen Jelley and Team HARD's Carl and have enjoyed some stellar results so far.

Team HARD's final season with the Volkswagen CC has delivered mixed results so far but the trio of Jack Goff, Mike Bushell and Nicolas Hamilton will be looking to land some serious points.

Rounding out the ultra-competitive entry list for former Ginetta GT4 Supercup Am champion is the Racing Vauxhall, following in the footsteps of Mike Bushell, Rob Austin and Jade Edwards.

With three blockbuster races scheduled to play out around the 2.13-mile layout of Croft, the BTCC will take centre stage this weekend and it is not to be





It's still advantage Luke Browning at the top of Roman Bilinski has been enjoying a consistent run the F4 British Championship certified by FIA powered by Ford EcoBoost standings, but the momentum is with the chasing pack heading to Croft this weekend.



Zak O'Sullivan, Casper Stevenson and Alex Connor - the three drivers closest to Browning - split the victories at Silverstone last time out, with closest challenger O'Sullivan scoring a podium hat-trick to reduce the arrears to 33 points with eight races still

First-time winner Stevenson is now just a further 20 markers behind, and both Connor and JHR's James Hedley - fourth and fifth overall - will need a strong weekend in Yorkshire to keep their title bids alive and kicking.

Crucially, Ford's rising stars will be without a reversegrid race this weekend, with both grids set from their fastest and second-fastest times in qualifying respectively.

Croft is among the hardest circuits to overtake at on the calendar, so a strong qualifying from Browning could yet see him keep the others at arm's length and stabilise his lead heading into the title run-in. Behind the leading quintet, a whole host of drivers have already shown their ability to fight for podium finishes in 2020, and could yet throw a spanner in the works for the title contenders.



A nightmare weekend for former points leader Tom Lebbon (Elite Motorsport) last time out at Silverstone, coupled with a double race win himself, means Voisin (R Racing) is back at the top of the standings. He has seven wins to his name, having won at least once per race meeting this year.

Moving up to second in the standings meanwhile Josh Rattican (Elite Racing). Race victories in recent meetings at Knockhill and Thruxton, alongside impressive podium consistency, means he lies 30 points behind Voisin at this stage.

Ginetta Junior Scholar Lebbon will aim to fightback this weekend as he continues his quest to become the first ever rookie driver to win the overall title. Georgi Dimitrov (Richardson Racing) holds similar ambitions, and a fourth win of the season at Silverstone has kept him in contention.

Two standout talents from the Silverstone meeting were rookies William Vincent (Elite Motorsport) and Tom Edgar (TCR). Both were right in the mix for the race wins and each secured their first overall podium finish and rookie class victory in the championship.

Elite Motorsport's team of rookies are in impressive form. Josh Miller took a maiden outright podium at Thruxton, Seb Hopkins has been knocking on the door with two top five finishes recently, while William Aspin picked up career best qualifying and race results at Silverstone.

Ten different drivers have scored overall top three results so far this season. R Racing duo Aston Millar and Joel Pearson, plus Zak Taylor (Alistair Rushforth Motorsport), complete that group. Freddie Tomlinson, also R Racing, has been a top three contender in recent meetings.



Will Jenkins (Elite Racing) and Tommy Pintos (Elite Motorsport) have both come close to overall silverware this season too with best finishes of fourth place, while Liam McNeilly (Fox Motorsport) and Trennon Bettany (Richardson Racing) are top ten finishers aiming to push forwards.

Seven points split the top three drivers in the Millers Oils Ginetta GT4 SuperCup as Croft plays host to the latest chapter of a fascinating 2020 title story, writes Simon Paice.



The championship lead has been shared out between Tom Hibbert (Triple M Motorsport), Will Burns (Rob Boston Racing) and Gus Burton (Century Motorsport) across the season so far, with Hibbert the current occupier after recording a third win of the season last time out at Thruxton.

Hibbert will be aiming to increase his points advantage at a circuit he won at last season, however it won't be easy. Burton has been a revelation in his maiden campaign and finished off the podium just once, while Burns is a consistent podium finisher with a wealth of experience in the series.

The in-form driver heading to North Yorkshire is a driver aiming to battle his way into title contention, Jamie Falvey (Motion Capital Racing). After scoring a breakthrough podium at Oulton Park, he continued a brilliant debut campaign with a sensational double victory at Thruxton.

Adam Smalley (Elite Motorsport) is a race-winner too, back at Brands Hatch. He'll want to add more to his tally, while Reece Somerfield (Privateer) – who made history at Thruxton with his 200th start in the GT4 SuperCup – and Joe-Marshall-Birks (Rob Boston Racing) are podium contenders too.

Chris Salkeld (Assetto Motorsport) currently leads a hotly-contested Pro Am class by only nine points from Colin White (CWS Motorsport), who's on course to make his 200th GT4 SuperCup start this weekend. Tom Emson (Elite Motorsport) is a four-time class race-winner meanwhile.

He, along with teammates Bradley Gravett and Alfie Guy Glenie, will be aiming for further silverware. Leonardo Panayiotou was another driver to pick up a trophy in Norfolk and along with Harry Nunn, both remain championship contenders.



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CAYMAN ISLANDS PORSCHE SPRINT CHALLENGE GB

PORSCHE 718 CAYMAN GT4 CLUBSPORT RACES IN TO SUPPORT BTCC

Cayman Islands Porsche Sprint Challenge GB makes its debut on the TOCA package during a maiden season that has seen the new-for-2020 championship firmly establish itself on the British motor sport calendar. Featuring a race version of the award-winning Porsche 718 Cayman GT4, the championship runs alongside Porsche Carrera Cup GB which has been part of the BTCC package since its first race in 2003.



Until now, this new championship has made appearances on the British GT and Porsche Club GB packages but arrives at Croft for its penultimate weekend in the middle of a fierce duel for championship honours.

The field of identical 425 hp 718 Cayman GT4 Clubsport cars places the focus on individual driver and team performance across two main categories: Pro and Am. The 'Pro' category typically attracts experienced drivers gunning for the outright championship, while 'Am' provides those transitioning into top-line UK motorsport their own benchmark.

Two names familiar to fans of the TOCA package – James Dorlin (IN2 Racing) and Tom Jackson (Rob Boston Racing) – are separated by just five points at the top of the championship table. The pair have taken four wins apiece, with Jackson dominating the Donington Park weekend last time out - but with four races still to run, there's everything still to play for in North Yorkshire. Hoping to upset the established form guide is YouTube star Archie Hamilton (Redline Racing) and 16-year old Theo

Edgerton (Total Control Racing) – both have stood on the second step of the podium in 2020 and will be desperate to go one better before the season finale at Silverstone next month.



Meanwhile, newcomer and former W Series racer Sarah Moore (IN2 Racing) is one to watch – she is gaining speed and confidence with every session as she adapts to racing the mid-engined 718 Cayman GT4 Clubsport.

Ambrogio Perfetti (IN2 Racing) - with his distinctive Chupa Chups livery - has taken five Am category victories so far this season to surge ahead in the points table. However, category rival lan Humphris (Valluga) has closed the gap in recent races and is putting the Norwegian under increasing pressure. Perfetti and Humphris arrive at Croft with just 12 points between them, but both will need to keep an eye on experienced racer Nigel Rice (Redline Racing), the former Porsche Carrera Cup GB driver having recorded six Am category podium finishes this season. Likewise, 72-year-old Peter Chambers (JRT) and John Westbrook (Rob Boston Racing) have already tasted the winner's champagne and will remain in the hunt around the technically challenging Croft circuit..
