## Harewood Hillclimb - Saturday 8 May & Sunday 9 May 2021 Competitors Guidance - 1

This guidance is subject to change as HM Government and Motorsport UK guidelines are updated. It has been prepared in order that we might safely take part in the sport we love and as such would ask that you show care and consideration at all times.

Please remember that the actions of one person can compromise the safety of all those present at an event and as such the greatest level of care must be exercised. If you don't feel safe in the current climate and within the constraints of what is listed below then please do not enter the event.

There will be many changes to the usual procedures, as follows:

All event communications will be by email. Please read <u>all</u> emails and website announcements carefully and thoroughly. You may also wish to familiarise yourself with the latest information on the Motorsport UK website.

Signing-on will be in advance, electronically, the competitors signing-on and pre-event scrutineering selfdeclaration form will be sent to you by email. This must be completed and emailed back by the required date; we cannot accept any forms by post. If you fail to return the form within the required timescale, you will not be signed on for the event and therefore ineligible to participate.

On the day of the event, you must still bring all appropriate documentation with you, such as your competition licence and valid club membership card, as spot checks will be made. You should also expect the scrutineers to make checks on a small number of competition cars, observing social distancing, along with checks on your equipment such as overalls, helmets, etc.

Overnight camping WILL be permitted for self-contained units only. Anyone wishing to camp needs to preregister. The toilet blocks will be locked overnight, showers will not be available. The entrance gates will be locked until 07.00 on the event day and will then be open until 10.00, after which time there will be no admittance to Harewood.

BARC Yorkshire is required to observe the latest rules on social gatherings and control the amount of people in attendance at its events. Motorsport events are to be held behind closed doors until further notice. Regrettably, therefore, we have to restrict the number of helpers you can bring to site (no children under 16) and their names and mobile phone numbers must be provided in advance for them to be allowed in. Officials and marshals are not allowed to bring any guests. Passes will not be issued and only individuals on the gate list will be admitted to Harewood. There will be no spectators allowed and any additional persons attempting to gain access on the day will be turned away.

Double driven (shared) cars will be allowed. It is the competitors' responsibility to ensure all contact parts are sanitised sufficiently between driver changeovers. To allow more time for this, the No 1 drivers will run in their own class batch and the No 2 drivers will run two batches prior, the exception to this will be in the first batches of each run sequence where the No 2 drivers will run two batches later.

Competitors will not be permitted any form of tyre covers beyond their allocated paddock space. If tyre wrap is used, this must be removed from the tyres before the car leaves its allocated paddock space and all your waste should be removed from site, at the conclusion of the meeting.

If you come to a halt on the hill, a marshal will approach your car, face on and at a safe distance. If you are ok, please indicate with a "thumbs-up" to the marshal. Please continue to respect social distancing at all times.

There will be no access to the Paddock Office, so any communications with event personnel should be via email, text message or phone. There will be no competition numbers for sale, no notice board or times displayed in the Paddock Office; times will be available through the Harewood live timing website.

Awards - there will be no FTD or Class Awards for this event.

Catering - there will be a takeaway Frothy Coffee Van in the Paddock but no catering marquee at Harewood until further notice.
