Bulletin 003 - A Day's Marshalling

For the first time this year drivers in the Championship can gain 3 championship points for completing a full day on the bank marshalling.

Over the last few years the championship has been won by a small margin and gone down to the last round. With these three points it may be that in the future the Championship may be decided based on who has been marshalling and who has not.

The day does not have to be a meeting at which the Championship is on the bill, any circuit at any time will suffice.

There is a form that you have received (and it is in the forms section at the bottom of any CNC Heads page on the barcnorthwestern.co.uk web site). This will need to be completed by the driver and signed by the Chief Marshal at the relevant meeting before being sent to the Championship Co-ordinator before the penultimate meeting of the year (Donington Park on the 29th September).

If you do decide to take up this opportunity and learn what it looks like from the other side of the bank then all you need to do is make contact with the appropriate Chief Marshal a few weeks in advance of the meeting at which you want to marshal.
