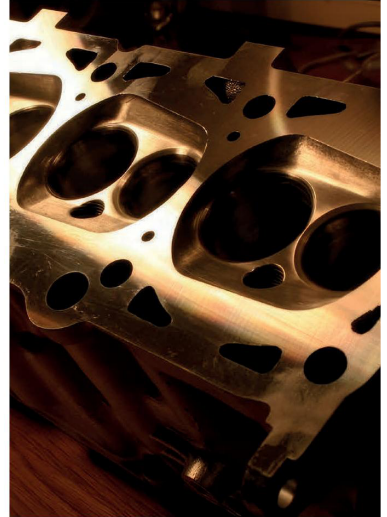

# RACE FOR THE TCR UK TITLE SET TO RAMP UP AT OULTON

**We welcome you to Oulton Park in Cheshire for rounds 12 & 13 of the 2025 TCR UK Touring Car Championship. It's a pleasure to have you join us trackside as we continue into the second half of the season.**

With six rounds left, it's all to play for in the TCR UK Drivers title after events at Croft last month the championship turned on its head.

Oulton provides the Summer Spectacular for TCR UK, with Qualifying and two races on the same day, so it's essential to score well and limit the damage across all three sessions.

We have a new championship leader in Callum Newsham, who leads the way after dropped scores are taken into account. Two second places and the race two win (following Adam Shepherd's disqualification) from Croft have put the JH Racing Hyundai driver up front.

Shepherd is only 27 points behind Newsham but he has been the pace setter this year. Pole, two fastest laps and three wins on the road put the Capture Motorsport in a commanding position; however, his DSQ from race two changed the points around.

Sam Laidlaw lies in third place, a further 31 points behind Shepherd, with father Steve Laidlaw in fourth place after a bruising weekend in North Yorkshire. Both of the Area Motorsport drivers will be out to close the gap as they look to get the maximum out of their Cupra Leon VZ TCRs.

Finn Leslie lies in fifth place after taking his second podium finish of the season in the Power Maxed Racing Hyundai and will aim to add to that tally at the Cheshire venue.

# OULTON PARK NEXT UP FOR ALL-ACTION MILLTEK CIVIC CUP RACERS

**The Oulton Park venue in Cheshire welcomes the 2025 Milltek Civic Cup for rounds 12 and 13. It's a delight to have you join us trackside for our latest racing event.**

Using the Island layout, the drivers and teams are locked in for the final three double-header events of the year, with six rounds to go. Oulton Park also throws in an extra challenge: Qualifying and both races occur on the same day.

Alistair Camp leads the points standings in his Area Motorsport run Civic FN2, however, teammate Liam McGill closed in on his lead at Croft in his EP3. McGill is just 12 points behind Camp after his big points haul in North Yorkshire.

Lewis Kent lies in third place, with ground to make up after missing the third race at Croft for the birth of his son. Kent is a hard charger and will be working to close down the points gap.

Jake Hewlett returned to his earlier form at Croft as he stood on the podium twice, with that first victory still eluding him. Wesley Swain lies in fifth place, also from the Area

stable, wanting to put his FN2 back up front and fight for that first win.

Harvey Caton is on the comeback trail after suffering two DNFs from Silverstone and Croft, whilst 2025 race winners Dave Marshall and Jack Ruddell will be out to add to their tally.

An Open Paddock Access on Saturday means that the fans can have a look around the teams and the cars, getting the chance to take a further look at the EP3 and FN2 models, which will go head to head using a Balance of Performance to keep all cars equal.

Class A sees Simon Allaway out again looking for some overall wins, but for an unfortunate incident on the start line at Anglesey he would have a faultless record. Simon's Esprit will have competition from Garry Wardle's ex TCR Audi A3, Ryan Nelson's Ginetta and the very quick BMW of Philip White. Look out for the lovely Bentley GT of Ash Hicklin.

As always the nimble and very quick 'Caterfields' in Class B will be out to spoil the Class A party! Leading these will probably be the Locos 7 of Ben Roberts and the Caterham 7 of Bod Buckby. The Island configuration that we are using today may suit these open cars more than the usual International circuit. The Modro brothers (Connor & Alek) have suffered some bad luck this season in their immaculate Westfield Aero's so will be hoping for better luck today, if they get it they will be fast.

Moving to the larger modified Class D now (as John Edwards-Parton will probably have Class C all to himself!). It looks like we will see the continued battle of the team-mates Chris Roberts and Carl Bennet in their quick BMWs. Waiting to pounce on any non-finish from this pair will be 2024 Champion Steven Parker in his Ford Fiesta, David Jones in his Ford Focus and Oliver Thomas in his Subaru.

With five straight class wins and joker played successfully, Paul Rotheroe in his unique, beautifully prepared and very quick Citroen Xsara, will be out to protect his Class E and overall lead in the Championship. Last years runner up Lee Bull (Renault Clio) missed Anglesey but if he is out today he will provide stiff competition for Paul as will Matthew Jones in his Ford Focus.

The small Modified Class F has seen something of a resurgence this season. Last year saw Helen Allen in her Fiesta usually alone but she has some competition this season. Errol Taylor with his Toyota Yaris T Sport, Rob Wakelin's Honda Civic and Jonathan Lee will be aiming to stop Helen winning the class.

Today, competitors in the CNC Heads Sports/Saloon Championship will be competing for the prestigious Dave Simpson Memorial Trophy. This must be one of the most sought after trophies in club motorsport and is eagerly competed for each year.

The trophy was presented to the Centre by Margaret Simpson in honour of her husband Dave. Back in the early days of the series, as it was then, Dave was instrumental with Ken Mitchell and John Leck in setting up the championship.

With grids of perhaps 10/12 cars back then it did not look too good for the success of the Championship. However with Dave's encouragement and enthusiasm the Championship grew from strength to strength and within a few years we saw grids of over 30 regularly.

The Trophy will be competed for in the first

race and be decided by the driver who wins his or her class and has the greatest speed differential to the driver coming second. This basically translates to the driver who is most dominant in their class. The only proviso is that there must be at least three starters (and of course at least two finishers!). In 2024 the winner was Marshal Groves in his Vauxhall Vectra Challenge car.

Good luck to all drivers in your pursuit of the Trophy this year.

# JSCC REVVED UP FOR A BLAST AROUND THE PARK IN CHESHIRE

**Oulton Park provides the setting for the Junior Saloon Car Championship this weekend and with the business end of the season rapidly approaching, the battle for supremacy at the top of the standings is set to reach fever pitch.**

Billed as one of the UK's leading championships for drivers aged 14 to 17, the one-make series has delivered its fair share of edge-of-the-seat entertainment this year - and more is expected around Oulton Park's Island layout.

Wilf Butler heads to the scenic Cheshire venue as the driver to beat having opened up a 26-point advantage over his nearest rival. Five wins have provided the backbone to Butler's charge and he'll be hoping to add to his tally further across Saturday's two bouts.

Leading the chase for the second-year racer is fellow race winner Josh Salvadorai, whilst third-place man Oliver Kerr arrives with momentum on his side having twice triumphed last time out at Croft.

Lewis Stannard and Luca Maserati complete

the top five but despite making strong starts to the season, they have both dropped off the lead pack in recent rounds. Watch out for them as they look close the gap.

Further down the order, Ollie Smith is the lead rookie and he'll no doubt renew his ultra-competitive battle with Max Scharfeggar. Elsewhere the trio of Matthew Swatton, Kyle Wells and Louis Austin will be aiming to mix it towards the sharp end of the field.

Other drivers to keep a close eye on throughout the day includes the likes of Tom Algar, Joe Wood, Scholarship winner Martin Wright, Lexie Powell, Leon Holly, Sherrie Ann Powell, Timothy Leonard and Bailey Roberts.

Two races are scheduled to play out today around the 2.223-mile Island layout of Oulton Park and if previous Junior Saloon Car Championship events are anything to go by - this will be one spectacle you won't want to miss.

**It's been a full-throttle first half of the season for the Track Action Racing Club and the multi-marque series is showing no sign of slowing down as it rolls into Oulton Park this weekend for two more races.**

The Deutsche Marques Cup is the first of several multi-marques categories that make up the grid, with this one being for those that have an interest in driving cars that have been manufactured in Germany.

Paul Roddison, a former winner of the coveted BARC President's Cup, has been one of the standout names in the category so far with his Skoda Octavia proving to be perfect machine to catapult him into race-winning contention.

Both the Tricolore Trophy and the Peugeot 206 GTi Cup has had good representation this season and it will come as no surprise that this is where those wanting to hustle French-built machines will be competing over the course of the weekend.

Shaun Goverd dominated proceedings last time out at Croft in his Citroen AX and if he takes to the Island layout of Oulton Park then expect him to be in contention for outright honours once again.

William Di Claudio punched in some impressive performances during the early rounds whilst the Peugeot 206 GTi contingent of Andrew Mitchell, Noah Checkley, Jake Richardson, Matt Anderson and Martin Cayzer are always good value as well.

Completing the Track Action field is the Nippon Challenge, the race series for modified and production spec Japanese and Asian cars.

Multiple Classic Touring Car Racing Club champion Gary Prebble was a force to be reckoned with in his Honda Civic when the series visited Silverstone and Thruxton however last time out at Croft it was all about Callan Trump in his Nissan 350Z.

## FLAG SIGNALS



### BLUE

**(Steady)** Another competitor is close.

**(Waved)** Another competitor is trying to pass.



### YELLOW

**(Waved)** Danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

**(Double Waved)** Great danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.



### WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.



### YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.



### GREEN

Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.



### RED

Stop Racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by a marshal (at startline and individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.



### BLACK/ORANGE DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver; call into pits immediately.



### BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to drivers that his/her behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he/she may be black flagged.



### BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.



### BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED

End of the race.
