Andover bridge maintenance work

Between July 2017 and January 2018 Highways England is undertaking essential repairs to the Thruxton Hill, Kimpton Quarley and Picket Twenty bridges near Andover in Hampshire. Work at each bridge will involve replacing the waterproofing material under the carriageway, replacing the expansion joints and resurfacing.

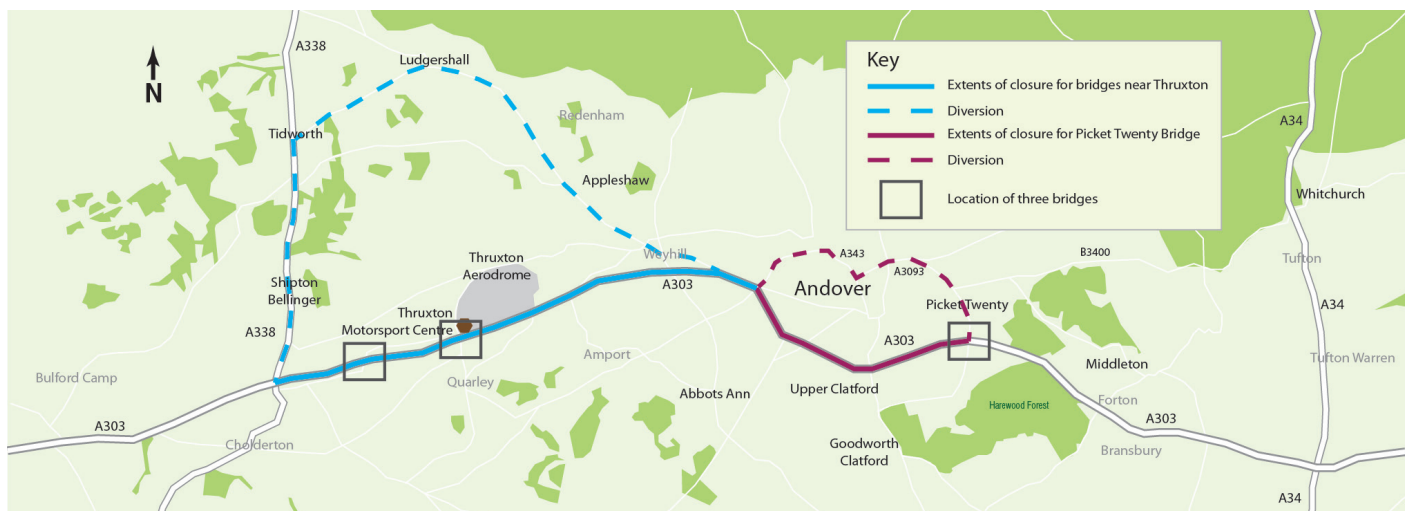
To allow the waterproofing material and expansion joints to be replaced we will need to shut the A303 on selected weekends, from **9pm Friday through to 6am Monday**.

Thruxton Hill and Kimpton Quarley - the A303 will be fully closed between the A338 Parkhouse Cross and A343 Hundred Acre junctions on the following weekends:

Picket Twenty - the A303 will be fully closed between the A343 Hundred Acre and A3093 Picket Twenty junctions on the following weekends:

- Friday 15 to Monday 18 September 2017 - Eastbound
- Friday 22 to Monday 25 September 2017 - Westbound
- Friday 3 to Monday 6 November 2017 - Eastbound
- Friday 1 to Monday 4 December 2017 - Westbound

During the closures clearly signed diversions will be in place.

Significant delays will be expected. Please avoid this route or allow extra time where possible.
