We will be taking extensive measures to ensure the health and wellbeing of our guests and colleagues throughout the venue by implementing strict social distancing when moving around the venue or inside the buildings, and other preventative measures in our facilities to ensure we can operate safely. This includes clear signage and enhanced cleaning procedures.

In addition to this, we have sourced and invested in hand sanitiser stations, anti-viral surface cleaning products and protective safety screens where appropriate.

We do however rely heavily on the cooperation of our visitors to comply with the latest government guidance and best practice to ensure a safe venue for all. In line with Government guidance, if you are displaying any symptoms whatsoever (new/persistent/continuous cough, fever and loss or change to your sense of smell/taste) you should not attend Thruxton under any circumstances.

At the start of the day before any guests arrive, all public area surfaces and all vehicles in use will be wiped down with an approved antibacterial/antiviral odourless cleaner.

This procedure will be repeated for every vehicle between each customer drive.

On arrival, all guests must park in the customer car park as marked on the paddock map below. Please allow plenty of space between vehicles to allow other guests enough space.

All guests must wash or sanitise their hands and fit a face mask before entering any building at Thruxton.

GUESTS, REFRESHMENTS AND VIEWING AREAS

Guests are welcome free of charge, however, entry to the various buildings will be limited so they should attend expecting to be outside for the majority of your visit. There are plenty of viewing areas of the circuit and cars.

THE RESTAURANT WILL BE OPEN FOR TAKEAWAY FOOD AND DRINK, HOWEVER, THIS WILL NEED TO BE TAKEN OUTSIDE TO CONSUME

Arrival

On arrival at Thruxton, follow the signs to the car park, located next to the Thruxton Centre. There is plenty of space for you to park your car. Please keep a larger than normal gap to the next vehicle.

There are a number of large signs reminding you to follow current social distancing guidance. You will see many more during your visit or signs indicating a one-way system. Please help us maintain both elements whilst you are at Thruxton.

Once parked, please make your way into the Thruxton Centre to collect your paperwork, only the person participating is allowed to enter the building, except for Junior drivers who can bring a parent/guardian in with them.

Please wear a face mask and sanitise your hands before entering any building at Thruxton.

BRIEFING

Once you've collected your paperwork, you will be given instructions on where to wait before your briefing starts. We will call drivers to the briefing room at your start time.

The driver briefing is for drivers only, we have ensured that you'll be able to socially distance whilst this is taking place.

DRIVING

All of our instructors will be wearing face masks when in a car. They will also sanitise their hands immediately before and after getting in and out of a car.

We ask that all participants do the same - please ensure you bring a face mask with you.

The cars you drive will have their touchpoints sanitised between each drive.

We do not wear helmets in the saloon, sports or supercars. If you are driving a single-seat racing car we will give you a helmet that has been sanitised. We will offer you a clean laundered balaclava and a pair of gloves.

You must have your arms and legs covered when driving the Racing Cars. Please bring your own suitable clothing for this element.

You will be asked to sanitise your hands before putting on any of this equipment.

If you are driving the Racing Cars we recommend purchasing the "Hygiene Pack" which includes a balaclava and gloves. You can pay for this at Registration for £3.00 and collect in the pit lane before driving the racing.

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY & IN-CAR VIDEOS

We have professional photographers out on track and in the pitlane to capture your driving experience, we also have in-car cameras in the majority of our cars to record your drive.

Our photo and video sales team will be based in the pit garages where you can collect your photos.
